- Time 1800-2100hrs on Thursday
- Will be going station to station every week
- Rotation will be 181,183,184
- A driver from the station the crew will be at needs to be part of duty crews until we are all cross trained on vehicles.
- That stations Battalion Chief can leave an assignments or tasks that he/she would like to be accomplished during the time they are in station.
- Truck Check and SCBA checks will be done during duty crew.
- If an officer is not on the duty crew, the firefighter that has his NJ Level I will assume the duties of Officer in charge.
- The duty Crew is responsible for clean up after themselves and maintaining cleanliness of the truck they will be crewing.
- Station equipment needs to be accessible for the crew in case they need to do a minor repair to equipment. If it needs major repair, the Officer will contact the Station Battalion Chief.
- Dress code will be enforced by the Officer in Charge, Shirt, Pants/ Jeans, and Boots, Sneakers are required. You can wear station shirts/ job shirts.
- If you are committed to the duty crew and you don't show up, the Officer in Charge will let the Station Battalion Chief know.
- Duty Crew Officer or PIC will list all personnel on the duty in the IAR program
- Duty Crew Cancelations will be transmitted to all department personnel through the IAR program.
